**The Flavor of Wisconsin: History and Culture through Recipes**

Wisconsin's food traditions reflect the richness of an ethnically and agriculturally diverse region. In this presentation, Terese Allen draws from her newly published second edition of *The Flavor of Wisconsin*, a food history with 460 recipes, co-authored by the late Harva Hachten. Terese tracks the magnificent cornucopia of what Wisconsinites have gathered, grown, produced, cooked, and eaten—from cranberries to specialty cheese, Cornish pasties to Hmong egg rolls, fish boil to a double with the works.
